## **Request for a Reduced Course Load**

F1 visa holders are required by United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) to maintain full-time student status (12 credit hours) in both the fall and spring semesters. However, USCIS recognizes situations in which students may enroll for fewer credits than normally required. In order to authorize an F-1 student for less than a full course load in the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS), requests for reduced course loads must first be discussed with International Student Services. If approved, the student should maintain a copy of this form, and a copy will be placed in his/her immigration file. It is always the student's responsibility to maintain his or her own F-1 status.

Students must have this form completed and submitted to International Student Services PRIOR to dropping below (or registering for less than) 12 credits. Failure to do so will result in loss of F-1 status. **This form is valid for ONE semester only.**
