## **LPN Pathway to RN**

The LPN Pathway to RN is designed to prepare Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs) to become Registered Nurses (RNs).

- LPN students must meet all criteria for admission to the Nursing Program required of all applicants to the Program. See the LPN Degree Sheet.
- Eligibility for acceptance to the LPN Pathway to RN includes a valid LPN license.
- LPN students must successfully complete the LPN Pathway to RN 3-credit course (NUR 11500) and demonstrate competency in the required fundamentals skills prior to taking their first Nursing Process course.
- Upon successful completion of the LPN Pathway to RN course (NUR 11500) and demonstrated competency in the required fundamentals skills, LPN students will have 7 transfer credits applied for the fundamentals courses – Nursing Fundamentals I (NUR 11600) and Nursing Fundamentals II (NUR 11800).
- LPN students, like all nursing students, must pass the Calculations for Pharmacology (NUR 10300) Competency Examination or successfully complete the NUR 10300 course with their first Nursing Process course, Intro to Adult Health/Mental Health (NUR 14400), and before registering for Adult Health I (NUR 14600).
- Students may take one or both Nursing Process courses each semester.
